Abstract: This pre-university programme is open to students aged 16-17 who are highly motivated in studying STEM fields. Highlights include:

- Qualifications for international applicants:
 - For Geniko Lykeio students: overall score of 19/20, with 19/20 in Maths and relevant subjects
 - For IB students: Overall scores of 38-42, with scores of 6-7 in Maths and relevant science
- Options to demonstrate English language proficiency:
 - Duolingo (115 overall, minimum 105 in each band score)
 - TOEFL iBT (92 overall, minimum 20 in all elements)
 - IELTS (6.5 overall, minimum 6.0 in all elements)
