**Overall ability:** In terms of the *Common European Framework*, students will have to complete tasks and demonstrate skills typical of a **high A2 / B1** level.

As a more specific indication, students should have an excellent command of the following:

#### **Grammar and Syntax:**

- *Tenses (Regular and Irregular verbs: Present Simple & Continuous, Past Simple & Continuous, Present Perfect Simple, Past Perfect Simple and Future Simple)*
- *Conditional Sentences – Types 0, 1 & 2*
- *Nouns (Countable and Uncountable, Irregular Plurals)*
- *Relative Pronouns and Adverbs*
- *Possessive Pronouns and Adjectives*
- *Prepositions of Place and Time*
- *Comparison (Comparative / Superlative of Regular & Irregular Adjectives)*
- *Use of simple and compound sentences*
- *Subject-Verb Agreement*

#### **Reading Comprehension:**

Students should be able to read short, age-appropriate texts on familiar topics and answer both factual and critical thinking questions based on them.

#### **Writing:**

Students should be able to write a full-length composition, including an introduction, main body and conclusion (for example, a description or story).

#### **Oral fluency:**

Please note that although speaking is not part of the test for new entrants, both parents and students should be aware of the importance the school gives to speaking skills. English is the medium of instruction in English classes and other subjects, too.
